For the past 20 years, the Sentosa Express monorail system has been a reliable part of Singapore's transportation network. In addition, alternatives like cable cars and the urban Automated People Mover (LRT) contribute to the city's efficient public transit. Currently, an autonomous minibus shuttle is undergoing its final tests for approval for public use. We will be able to visit all these systems on the Technical Tour and discuss challenges and experiences.


