This is an opportunity to gain valuable insights, exchange feedback, and explore innovative solutions that will shape the future of sustainable urban mobility.

A special feature of our conference will be again the "Technical Visits". Singapore is clearly positioning itself as a pioneer for innovative mobility solutions. For the past 20 years, the Sentosa Express monorail system has been a reliable part of Singapore's transportation network. In addition, alternatives like cable cars and the urban Automated People Mover (LRT) contribute to the city's efficient public transit. Currently, an autonomous minibus shuttle is undergoing its final tests for approval for public use. We will be able to visit all these systems on the Technical Tour and discuss challenges and experiences.
